Altogether they cost \$98.60. Please give me the money so that I can buy the snacks. Thank you very much.

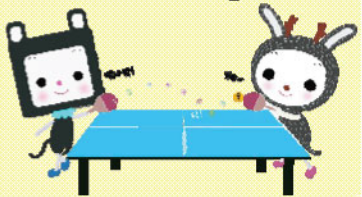
