Rice with Tomato and Mushrooms

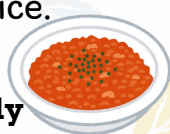
First cut the tomato, mushrooms and ham into small pieces.

I think this job is suitable for me because I am creative and hard-working. I am patient too. I hope I can be a pastry chef someday.

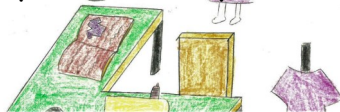


6C Fung Chi Man, Fairy
